WWYSA EQUALITY POLICY STATEMENT

- 1. WWYSA is committed to the principle of equality of opportunity and aims to ensure that all present and potential participants, members, instructors, coaches, competitors, officials and volunteers are treated fairly and on an equal basis, irrespective of sex, age, disability, race, religion or belief, sexual orientation, pregnancy and maternity, marriage and civil partnership, gender reassignment or social status.

- 5. The RYA reserves the right to discipline any of its members or who practice any form of discrimination in breach of this policy and WWYSA is fully supportive of this.
- 6. The effectiveness of this policy will be monitored and evaluated on an ongoing basis.
